# Tik Tok Trend

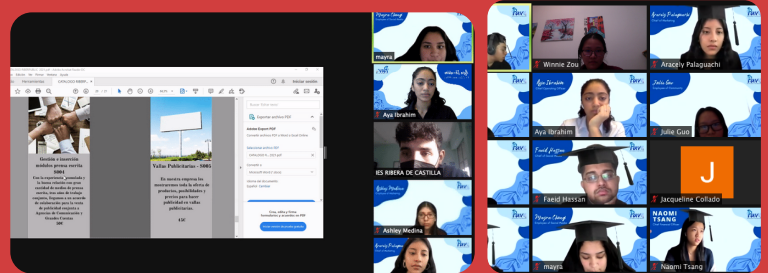

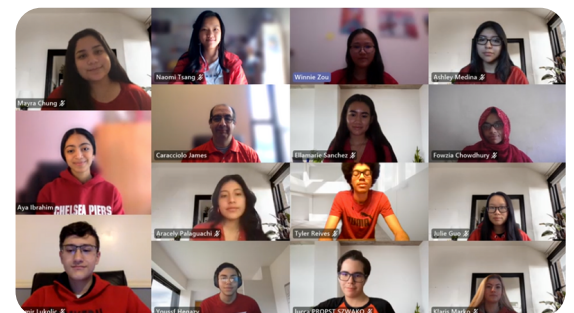
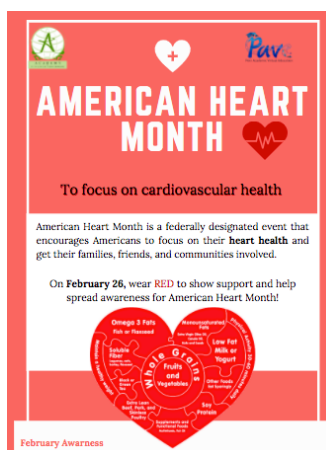
# Trade Show: International and National

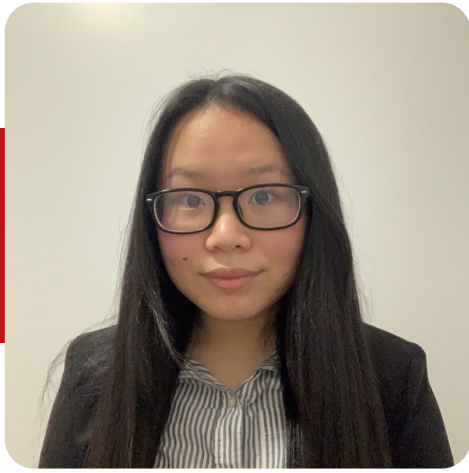

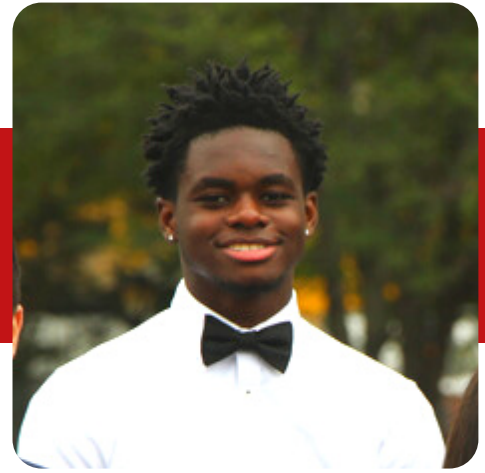
